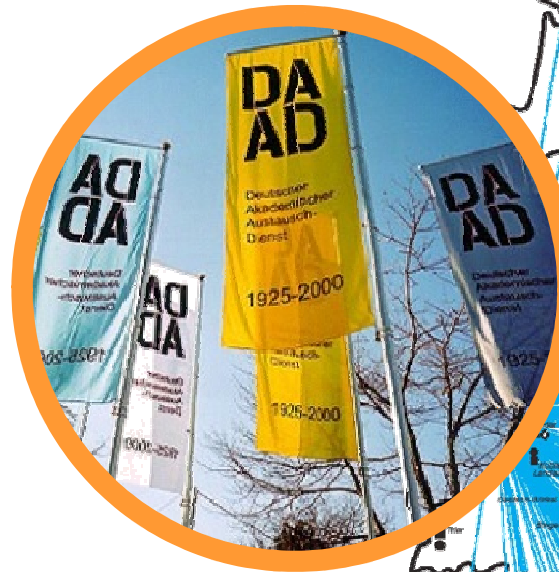

- a self-governing organisation of German universities:
- 232 member universities
- 124 student bodies



Introduction to the DAAD

The DAAD has...

- 62 Regional Offices and Information Centres (IC) all over the world
- an annual budget of around 300 Mio Euro
- 555 DAAD Lecturers
- 55.000 DAAD scholarship holders
- around 600 professors on 90 selection committees

- (Co-)responsible for “uni-assist”





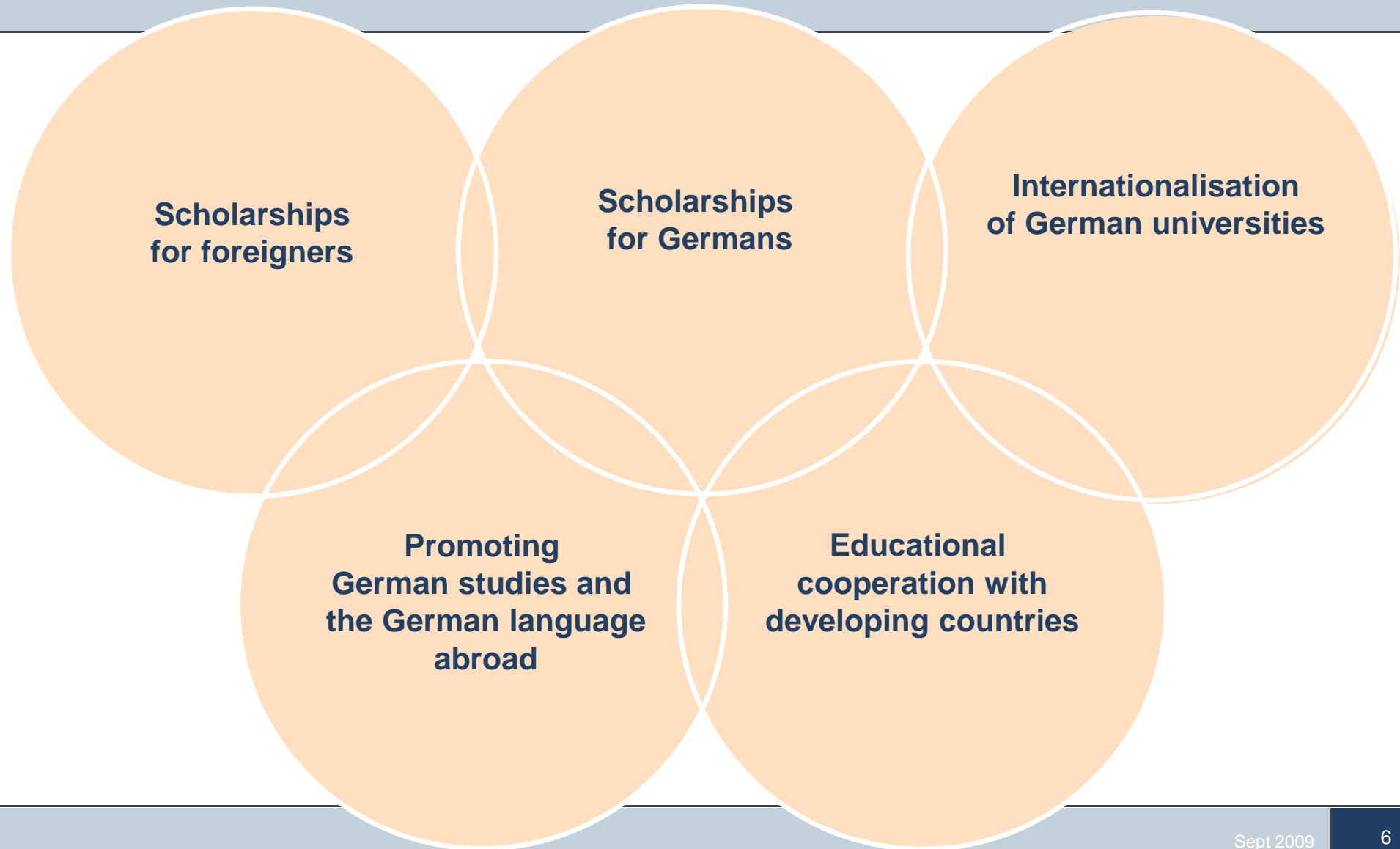
The DAAD network worldwide



The DAAD has 62 regional and local offices world-wide, more than 555 lecturers abroad and 120 Alumni Clubs.

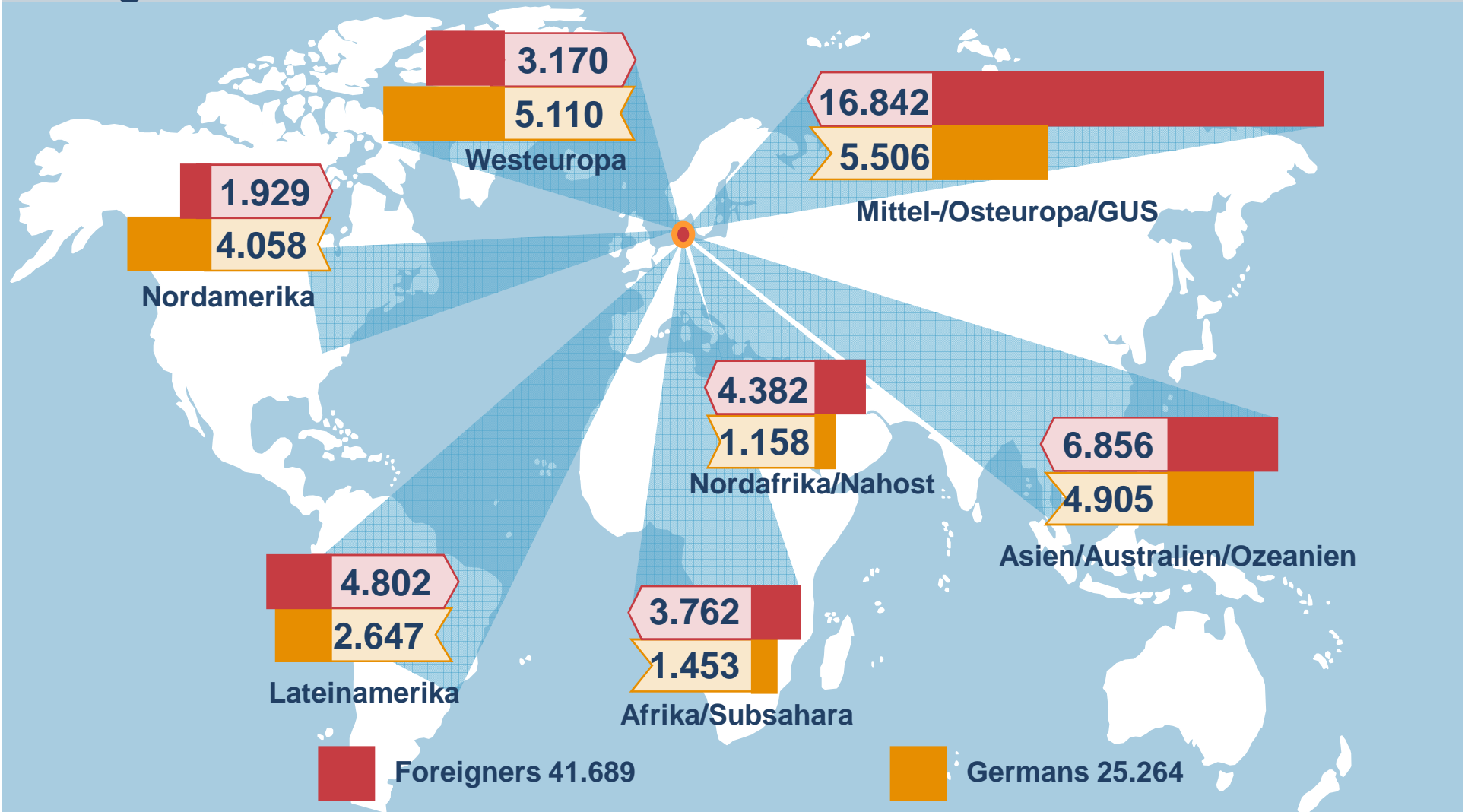


Goals and domains of the DAAD

Vision: Building up long-term partnership

The DAAD promotes the creation of high-quality and permanently self-sufficient higher education structures in developing and transitional countries. The programmes for those countries are focused on human and institutional capacity building.

Instruments:

Individual support and training for young academic staff as well as experts and executives (staff development)

Support for the construction of appropriate structures at the partner universities (institution building)

Provision of continuing education for Alumni from German institutions of Higher Education

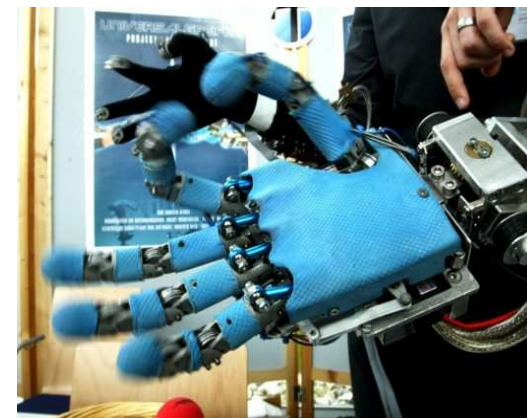
