Senior Lecturer/Lecturer/Junior Lecturer (Ref. A286)

Duties: A Senior Lecturer/Lecturer will be required to teach and supervise under- and postgraduate students, whilst a Junior Lecturer will be required to teach undergraduate modules in Media Studies. S/he will also participate in the research programmes in the Department.

Requirements: To qualify for the Senior Lectureship or Lectureship, candidates must have at least a PhD or MA degree in Media Studies (Communication) or a related field. S/he should have at least five (Senior Lecturer) or three (Lecturer) years' teaching experience at a tertiary institution or in a related field. Good communication skills, the ability to compile a teaching portfolio, evidence of research and creative work and curriculum development will be added advantages for the position of Senior Lecturer/Lecturer. An Honours degree in Media Studies or a related field is required for appointment as a Junior Lecturer. Evidence of teaching and assessment or tutorial sessions at an undergraduate level, good communication skills and engagement in research are further requirements for the Junior Lectureship.
