Topic : Ant diversity and ecosystem processes across an elevational gradient; functional versus taxonomic perspectives in the Soutpansberg Mountains, South Africa

In an age of rapid global environmental change, humans have to develop an understanding of the impact of these changes on ecosystems. Studies along elevations provide space for time substitutions that allow us to predict the future impacts of climate change. Mr Munyai's study focused on ants (Hymenoptera: Formicidae), an ecosystem engineer and indicator taxon that responds to the environment at point localities, across the western Soutpansberg mountains. His work represents the first long-term monitoring programme of ants across an elevational transect in the tropics of Africa and includes a five year time series. Long-term monitoring of this transect will provide insights into the rate and magnitude of ecosystem changes driven by global climate change. Mr Munyai's work identified the proximate drivers of ant diversity in both space and time.

Mr Munyai's study has led to the publication of two peer reviewed scientific papers in internationally acclaimed scientific journals. The main findings include:

- The importance of temperature and neutral processes in driving ant diversity and the consistency of patterns over time.
- Identification of indicator taxa associated with various elevation, slope/aspect and major habitat types along the mountain
- The role of competition in structuring ant assemblages and how it varies across elevations and habitats.

IZUAGIE ANTHONY ANABUI

Topic : Defluoridation of groundwater using raw, heat-treated and metal oxide-modified diatomaceous earth.

Groundwater is a source of drinking water for many rural communities in developing countries. The groundwater often contains chemical species above prescribed limits for drinking water, which can be detrimental to human health. One chemical species of concern is fluoride, which is often present in concentrations above the WHO standard of 1.5 mg / ℓ. Several studies have observed groundwater concentrations of up to 30 mg / ℓ in several provinces of South Africa. Such water requires defluoridation. A number of technologies have been developed for defluoridation of groundwater with mixed success. These include membrane filtration, precipitation-coagulation, aluminium sulphate based coagulation-flocculation sedimentation and adsorption. Disadvantages of these technologies include lack of technical expertise, electricity demand, lack of skills for use of chemicals in rural set-ups and low efficiency. Research has established that adsorption would be the most suitable

technology for rural set-ups but finding high capacity fluoride adsorbents is a challenge. The focus of Mr Izuagie's doctoral research was the development of a high capacity fluoride adsorbent based on diatomaceous earth (DE), in the form of binary Al/Fe oxide-modified DE, trimetal Mg/Ce/Mn oxide-modified DE and heat-treated binary Al/Fe oxide- and trimetal Mg/Ce/Mn oxide-modified DE. The capacity of the raw diatomaceous earth (DE) and its modified forms for fluoride adsorption were evaluated through batch experiments. Moreover, their chemical stability and regeneration potential were also evaluated. Raw diatomaceous earth was observed to be a poor defluoridation agent, even at optimum pH, and its modification is recommended. Of the synthesized mixed metal oxide modified DE, Mg/Ce/Mn oxide-modified DE was observed to have the highest capacity for defluoridation of groundwater and was recommended for upscale testing of the technology and even for fabrication of household defluoridation devices. Mr Izuagie's work has so far yielded two articles in DHET accredited journals while two other manuscripts are currently under review. Moreover, he has presented it at 3 conferences.

MASINDI VHAHANGWELE

Topic : Remediation of acid mine drainage using magnesite and its bentonite clay composite.

Citation

One of the most deleterious impacts of coal and gold mining in South Africa is generation of huge volumes of acidic effluents (Acid Mine Drainage-AMD). These effluents contain high concentrations of toxic ions such as Fe, Al, Mn and sulphate, and require treatment before being discharged into surface water bodies. Several technologies have been developed for treatment of AMD with mixed success. Mining companies are in constant search of new more efficient and cheaper treatment technologies. The focus of Mr Masindi's doctoral research was on treatment of AMD using mechanochemically modified cryptocrystalline magnesite-bentonite clay composite. This composite was reacted with AMD effluents in a batch set up and their capacity to increase the pH and remove inorganic contaminants evaluated over time. Solution modeling was accomplished using PHREEQC geochemical software. The technology developed was observed to remove $\approx 99\%$ of the metal species and $>90\%$ of the sulphate and other chemical species. The study led to the conclusion that the composite had a higher potential to neutralize acidity and attenuate potentially toxic chemical species from AMD than cryptocrystalline magnesite or bentonite clay used individually. The technology is recommended for scale up by the Murray and Roberts/CSIR/UNIVEN partnership in South Africa. Use of magnesite treatment technology is a novel concept and this was recognized through successful registration of two international patents. This work was also recognized nationally in 2015 when Mr Masindi received the JD Roberts award for Emerging Researchers from Murray and Roberts. Finally, this project has yielded 4 articles in DHET accredited, high impact journals and 5 conference presentations with proceedings.

DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN URBAN AND REGIONAL PLANNING

JAMES CHAKWIZIRA

Title : Access and constraints to commuting in Gauteng Province, South Africa

The thesis links access and constraints to commuting issues to the fragmentation of urban space to provide an understanding of the origin of commuting challenges in Gauteng Province. Mr. James Chakwizira critically analyzed the characteristics of travel patterns via various transport modes in Gauteng Province to provide new insights on the causes and impacts of constraints to origin and destination of journeys. Constraints to commuting have often been unpacked mainly from transportation demand and supply without bringing in spatial planning components. The consequences of pre-1994 urban spatial planning disparities and fragmentation of space were as a result of peripheral residential neighborhoods developments in townships far from city centers. This type of spatial planning imposed high transport fares on the poor, brought about delays in travel times and inadequate public transport services from peripheral locations to areas of economic opportunities. Further analysis and synthesis of the findings resulted in linking commuting constraints to spatial residential locational disadvantages among the poor. In addition to this, low income levels of majority of public transport users, increased car ownership as opposed to functional and flexible public transport systems like the BRT impacted negatively on commuters. The analyses resulted in the development of a spatial transport model to address the fragmentation of spaces with respect to transportation in Gauteng province and the integration of multimodal transport systems to connect urban areas of economic opportunities. The model attempts to demonstrate how spatially integrated multimodal transport network can reduce the fragmentation of space in Gauteng to the benefit of commuters. For the first time the views of commuters and their travel times: - from home to work, from work to shops and from shops to home were factored into the design of the spatial model. Mr. James Chakwizira was able to suggest an integrated and inclusive transport model in Gauteng that addresses disadvantaged urban residential locations.

Outputs: Mr. James Chakwizira has published six peer-reviewed papers in distinguished planning journals and he has attended international and local conferences and presented four research papers. He plans to publish three further papers from the completed work.
