The research was carried out to model cybersecurity policy implementation in Africa using South Africa as a case study. This proposed cybersecurity policy implementation framework will support the process of the implementation of cybersecurity in African countries to effectively control and protect the countries' cyber infrastructure and netizens. The research includes an analysis of the current cybersecurity environment in South Africa. The results were used to develop proposed implementation strategies, structures and sustainment measures as well as the factors that need to be taken into consideration for the implementation of cybersecurity that contributes to national security in Africa. Frameworks and toolkits were also developed in support of the implementation process. A cybersecurity environment model that included a semantic technology tool was developed that can be used for a holistic cybersecurity implementation process. In addition, the researcher critiqued the draft version of the National Cybersecurity Policy Framework (NCPF) and proposed a new organisational structure for South Africa. This critique influenced the process and the structure in the recently published NCPF which adapted a similar structure to the one proposed and published by the candidate. A new and unique research methodology is presented which can be applied to model problems in domains where uncertainty is rife and information needs to be gathered with a consensus view and modelled for decision support. This methodology is both quantitative and qualitative and has recently been published as a book chapter. The research has resulted in the publication of 10 peer reviewed conference papers, 4 journal papers and 2 book chapters.

Honourable Ambassador Fikile Sylvia Magubane is a career diplomat. She holds a Masters Degree in Public Administration from Harvard University and a BA in Economics and Accounting from the Universities of Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland. Her employment career includes positions as Human Resources assistant at Epic Oil Mills; Director of Protocol and Intergovernmental Relations, Gauteng Provincial Government; Head of the Secretariat of the Southern African Development Community's Committee of Central Bank Governors at The South Africa Reserve Bank; Consul General in New York, USA; Ambassador of the Republic of South Africa to Spain and Andorra; and Director of the Southern African Development Community, Ambassador Magubane is seconded to the technical secretariat at the new BRICS Development Bank headquarters in Shanghai. During her deplomatic career, Ambassador Magubane has worked tirelessly to promote international educational linkages between South African higher education institutions and their international counterparts.

Ambassador Magubane was closely involved in securing an agreement between the Fordham University in New York and the University of Pretoria that saw approximately 23 South African students attending Fordham University annually. She has also been instrumental in implementing the EUROSA: Erasmus Mundus Action 2 Partnerships scholarship program, funded by the European Commission. This programme promotes mobility for South African and European students, researchers, academic and administrative staff. Two staff members at Univen have benefited from this programme by completing the MBA in Sport Management qualifications in Spain.

Whilst at the Mission at Madrid, Ambassador Magubane increased bilateral political and economic consultations between Spain and South Africa with particular emphasis on trade and investment. Her tenure in Madrid has undoubtedly given rise to Spain recently becoming South Africa's seventh top trading partner in the European Union. More importantly, Spain's investments in South Africa have created 12,000 direct jobs and an additional 25,000 indirect jobs locally.
