Topic : Developing a Framework for Estimating Adaptation Cost to Climate Variability for Maize Farmers in Resettlement Areas of Chirumanzu District, Zimbabwe

Poorly managed adaptation costs hamper efforts to combat climate variability and change if not well-managed. Yet there are no universally accepted methods of estimating the costs. The methods currently in use are top-down and complex besides being associated with formidable computational challenges. A study of maize farmers operating in the resettlement areas of Zimbabwe was conducted to estimate the costs of adaptation to climate change. A context-specific, user-friendly framework for estimating adaptation costs was developed via a bottom-up approach. The framework is a simplified way of appraising adaptation costs on farm, which enables sustainable decision-making.

Topic : A Framework for Improving Community Based Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Planning in Fragile Areas: A Case of Jariban District, Somalia

Community participation in the provision of infrastructure for water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) services remains low in fragile areas. Dependence on donors fails to halt the surge in WASH-related diseases and unsustainable service delivery. Thus, a framework for improved community-based WASH planning in fragile areas was developed through a case study in Jariban District of Somalia. The critical pillars of sustainable WASH service provision in fragile contexts were confirmed to be deepening community participation through conflict resolution, community involvement in funding infrastructure projects, diversifying funding options and increasing the stock of WASH infrastructure.

Topic : Measuring Technical Efficiency of Small-scale Commercial Enterprises and their Contribution to the local Economy in Vhembe District, South Africa

Available evidence on unemployment, inequality and poverty rates in rural areas of South Africa reveals that small-scale commercial farming leads to sustainable local economic development (LED). Consequently, the year 2014 was coined *The Year of Family Agriculture*. However, the contribution of small-scale commercial farming to LED outcomes is based on partial knowledge. Therefore, a study was conducted to measure the technical efficiency of enterprises in this sector and related contribution to the economy of Vhembe District in Limpopo Province. Approximately, 64 % of small-scale commercial farming enterprises were found to be technically inefficient. A four-stage development plan for strengthening the connection between agrarian policies and programmes is proposed as a strategy to improve productivity.

Topic : Characterisation of South African cassava landraces (*Manihot esculenta* Crantz) and evaluation of process-induced changes on functionality of its flour

Cassava (*Manihot esculenta* Crantz), an important root crop mostly grown and consumed in the tropics is not well known in South Africa (SA). This research determined the morphological, physicochemical, structural, elemental and metabolic characterisation of two SA landraces: red (RCLR) and white (WCLR), highlighting their potential end-use properties. Response surface methodology was employed in determining the linear, interactive and quadratic effect of varying concentrations of chemical pre-treatment (0.6 – 3.4% w/v) and drying temperatures (45 – 74°C) on the thermal, functional and physicochemical properties of cassava flour (CF) from both landraces. Calcium chloride and citric acid were separately applied in pre-treatment on the flours. Four experimental groups: CF from red landrace pre-treated with citric

acid (CAR); CF from red landrace pre-treated with calcium chloride (CCR); CF from white landrace pre-treated with citric acid (CAW); and CF from white landrace pre-treated with calcium chloride (CCW) were comparatively evaluated. Experimental design, analysis, response plots and process optimisation were done with Stat-Ease design expert software (version 12). Physical and morphological analysis revealed that both landraces differ. Cyanide content of the root and flour were below WHO recommended safe consumption level of 10.00 mg/kg. Metabolic profiling, with the aid of GC-MS, revealed that phenolic acids were higher in WCLR. X-ray fluorescence spectrometry of CF revealed that landraces contained necessary minerals such as potassium, magnesium, calcium, phosphorus and iron. Differential scanning calorimetry showed that pre-treatment had an increasing effect on the gelatinisation temperatures and enthalpy of CF. The study showed the positive effect of pretreatment against enzymatic browning associated with cassava root processing. The flour of the landraces showed potential in flour-based food applications. Two journal articles have been published in DHET approved journals from the study.

Contamination of water resources with oil through accidental spillage or discharge of oily wastewater from industries is an issue of worldwide concern. Innovative technologies are required for remediation and recovery of oil contaminated wastewater. Mr **Oisaemi's** PhD-project was an attempt at developing novel materials for oil adsorption from oily wastewater. Mr Oisaemi employed silica extracted from diatomaceous earth to synthesize novel silica gels using non-templated methods. The study successfully created an optimized method for the extraction of silica from diatomaceous earth. The silica was surface grafted with selected organic materials such as polypyrrole, acetyl groups and a novel benzimidazolone based polymer to produce the porous silica gels. The silica gels exhibited high oil adsorption potential ranging from 98-99 % for initial oil concentrations of 6650 -9250 mg/L in wastewater. Mr Oisaemi's work has produced 4 articles in DHET accredited high impact journals and a peer reviewed conference proceeding.

Offoro Neema Kimambo holds BSc and MSc in Environmental Sciences from Sokoine University of Agriculture, Tanzania and Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, India, respectively. He did BSc (Hons) Meteorology from University of Pretoria, South Africa. He joined the School of Environmental Sciences at UNIVEN in 2017 for his PhD studies.

Offoro Neema Kimambo's thesis employed a multimethodological approach to test the hypothesis that climate variability and hydrological modification increase the threat of cyanobacteria harmful algae in aquaculture systems in the Ngerengere Catchment. The study found species of cyanobacteria that can potentially cause harm to aquatic species and that there are links between the HABs and climate and hydrological variations. Although it could be linked to other factors, during the survey farmers revealed that they sometimes feel itchy during and after fishing, which may be linked to toxic effects from CyanoHABs. Furthermore, this study is the first to report red tide in inland fish farms in Africa. This interdisciplinary work is groundbreaking, not only in climate science applications but also in Africa. The work will be an asset to the search for solutions for problems caused by CyanoHABs in aquatic systems which are poorly studied.

Groundwater is an important water resource that is often the main source of water supply for rural communities. Often due to geology of the rock hosting the aquifer the groundwater has high concentration of inorganic species such as F⁻ beyond recommended levels for drinking water and require treatment. Moreover, this water could also be contaminated with pathogens due to human activities. Mr Obijole work sought to synthesize innovative materials for treatment of this groundwater based on hydrothermally treated smectite rich clay soils. Through careful optimization of the hydrothermal treatment operation parameters including innovative introduction of pore forming agents, Mr Obijole succeeded in synthesizing innovative mesoporous adsorbents with increased surface area (17-74 m²/g) with moderate to high fluoride adsorption capacity (3.45 mg/g). Moreover, the synthesized adsorbents exhibited microbial potency indicating their potential for simultaneous fluoride removal and water disinfection in household treatment systems. Mr Obijole work has produced 2 articles in DHET accredited journals and one peer reviewed conference proceedings, 4 other manuscripts are under preparation for submission to peer reviewed journals.

Mr. Moffat Frank completed his Bachelor of Urban and Regional Planning (BURP) in 2014; a Master in Urban and Regional Planning (MURP) with a Distinction in 2016 from the University of Venda. His PhD titled "*Spatial transformation in the City of Polokwane, South Africa (1996-2016)*" is part of a bigger project on a National Research Foundation (NRF) Postgraduate Collaborative Training Project focusing on Resilience and Spatial Justice in South Africa's Built Environment: Generating interdisciplinary transformative knowledge. The research project is a partnership involving the University of Venda, Witwatersrand University, and Durban University of Technology. Mr. Moffat Frank's thesis interrogated the spatial transformation of the City of Polokwane in South Africa from 1996 to 2016. He investigated policy directions on demographic distribution, city structure and city texture, drivers of governance, social, cultural, and economic spatial transformation, and implications of spatial transformation on the environment, economy, social, governance and political dimensions. The key findings from the study unravel the complexities of spatial transformations in secondary cities not only in South Africa but in small-medium sized cities/towns of developing countries and emerging economies. The research generated spatial transformation maps for the City of Polokwane and developed an integrated framework for tracking spatial transformation in small and intermediate cities in South Africa. The thesis's findings and results are useful in recommending the establishment of a planning institute focusing on small and intermediate cities spatial transformation and planning agenda in South Africa. Mr. Moffat Frank published one (1) paper in a high impact peer reviewed international journal and three (3) conference proceedings. He intends to publish three (3) more Journal papers from the thesis.

Title : A model to support women who had on Intrauterine Fetal Death (IUFD) in Vhembe District of Limpopo Province, South Africa.

In South Africa, Limpopo Province has a high prevalence of Intrauterine Fetal Death (IUFD), at an average rate of 21.90% per 1000 LB. Women who had Intrauterine fetal Death (IUFD) are at risk of suffering from mental health problems if professional support is not given. In South Africa, during the study, the maternity guidelines address the support for women with live babies and remained silent on the support for women who had IUFD.

The purpose of this study was to understand the kind of support needed by women who had IUFD, then develop a model to support women who had IUFD, in the Vhembe District of Limpopo Province, South Africa. A qualitative approach using explorative, descriptive, and contextual designs was adopted. Results reveal that women's experiences of IUFD begun before contractions, during delivery, and after delivery which negatively affects their mental health. Based on these experiences, the women expressed their needed support throughout which include the following: to be prioritized and treated as an emergency on arrival at the health facility; their families to be involved from the beginning and the availability of resources at the primary health care level. The study recommends an investigation to assess the impact of the developed model on the mental health of women who had IUFD. A model developed was found innovative by the Vhembe District Department of Health. A manuscript is under round 3 review by the accredited journal. Doctor Vusiwana Patricia Letlalo was born in Majosi, Limpopo, and completed her matriculation at Rivubye, pursued her postgraduate studies at the University of Venda. Her study aimed to determine the kind of information that non-psychiatric professional nurses need regarding care for mental health care users in general wards, and develop a model to capacitate nurses in caring for Mental health care users in general wards, Limpopo Province, South Africa”. A qualitative approach using explorative, descriptive, and contextual design was adopted and guided by Bloom’s Taxonomy of teaching and learning theory, (2001). Results show that there are knowledge and skills deficits experienced by non-psychiatric professional nurses regarding the care of a mental health care user. Therefore, they need to be capacitated in the form of training where they are sent to relevant institutions for them to pursue a diploma in psychiatry; continuous in-service training, and workshops by the mental health experts. The study concludes that professional nurses without psychiatry caring for MHCUs in general wards need training in psychiatry to provide holistic care.

A training developed model was found innovative by the Vhembe District Department of Health and can improve quality patient care. A manuscript is under round 3 review at the accredited journal. Title : Development of a training programme to strengthen cervical cancer screening programme in Limpopo Province

Ngambi Doris `s thesis focused on developing a training programme to strengthen cervical cancer screening programme in Limpopo Province. A mixed-method sequential design was used in this study. The study was conducted in three phases. Phase one was a situational analysis, followed by the development of a training program in phase two, and validation of the developed programme in phase three. In phase 1a a qualitative exploratory, descriptive design was used and the quantitative approach followed a descriptive, analytic survey design. Qualitative data were collected from professional nurses using a semi-structured face-to-face interview using an interview guide. The quantitative data were collected from operational nurse managers and senior nurse managers through a self-administered questionnaire. Qualitative data were analysed using Tesch's open coding method while quantitative data were analysed using Statistical Package for Social Sciences (SPSS) version 26. The findings were merged using a joint display to determine the extent to which the two data confirm, contradict, or expand. The study revealed that structural factors such as lack of space and material resources and human resource factors such as attitudes and lack of competence contributed to inadequacy rate and failure to reach the set targets. A training programme was developed based on the findings, theoretical framework and SAQA guidelines. Validation was done with the aid of the Delphi technique in reaching consensus of the developed training programme by expert panelist of health professionals. The study recommends that health care professionals should maintain good standards of practice, and these can be achieved through competency.

Title : Development of strategies to improve psychosocial care and support services for improving cancer services at the hospitals in Limpopo Province

Ramutumbu Neo's thesis was to develop strategies to improve psychosocial care and support services for improving cancer services at hospitals in Limpopo Province. A qualitative research design which was exploratory, descriptive was used for phase one of the study. The target population were health care professionals who expressed the challenges they experience in rendering the psychosocial care and support needs and cancer patients who described their experiences of psychosocial care needs and both target groups provided suggestions thereof. Purposive sampling technique was used to sample participants. Phase two was development of strategies based on the findings of the first phase.

Health care professionals reported shortfalls of human resource in oncology care, poor patient administration and support in cancer services, poor co-ordination of cancer care services, concerns relating to conflicting values and norms concerns with disclosure of their diagnosis and observance of maladaptive personality traits affecting mental health-related quality of life. The cancer patients perceived a lack in emotional support, a lack of timeliness of care and co-ordination, and a lack of education on their treatment. Strategies yielded, informed the study that: recruitment of skilled health care professionals, improving and structuring oncology services, decentralizing treatment centers (oncologist out-reach services), patient navigation and cancer survivorship programmes. The draft strategies were verified by panelists of experts and the refined strategies have been drawn following three rounds of e-Delphi and the final strategies have been drawn. The important contribution of the study was outlined, the suggestions for further studies about the patients; maladaptive personality traits affecting mental health-related quality of life.

Providing psychosocial cancer care to patients and families as part of standard care in reducing distress and psychosocial morbidity associated with cancer and in fostering a better quality of life during and after treatment, increases survival.

Nursing profession has its expected traditions, conduct, ethics and moral values which all members are expected to abide to. These are transferred to learners as soon as they enter the profession through professional socialisation. The people who are entrusted on transferring these values in the clinical areas are professional nurses. In the recent years nursing, has been in the public domain for wrong reasons where nurses are labelled as uncaring, incompetent and rude towards patients. These could be attributed to poor professional socialisation of learners who complete their training without acquiring the skills, ethics and values of the profession. The purpose of this study was to explore the perception of professional nurses regarding their role in professional socialisation and to identify challenges that affect professional socialisation of learners and then develop guidelines for professional socialisation. The study was conducted at Vhembe and Capricorn districts of Limpopo Province. Findings revealed that professional nurses did not act as exemplary role models all the time, poor communication, governance and shortage of staff and materials negatively impacted professional socialisation. Wrong career choice, failure to adjust and poor support of learners were found to be impediments of professional socialisation. The guidelines provide professional nurses with simplified easy to follow recommendations on professional socialisation of learners. The study contributed to the body of knowledge since it will assist professional nurses to ensure that the qualified nurses are competent in practice and will observe the ethical and moral values of the profession. Two manuscripts from the study are under review.

Title : A Model to Promote the Use of Implant Contraceptive Method in Vhembe District, Limpopo Province

Implant contraceptive method provides long-term pregnancy prevention for a period of three to five years, depending on the type of the device. Implant contraceptive method is typically associated with lower failure rates in preventing unintended pregnancies than methods that required self-administration. The purpose of this study was to develop a model to promote the use of implant contraceptive method at Primary Health Care facilities in Vhembe District, Limpopo Province. The study was conceptualized within the Health Belief Model. This study focused on the six components of Health Belief Model, which are perceived seriousness, perceived susceptibility, perceived benefits, perceived barriers, modifying variables and cues to actions. The theory used to understand sexually active women's health-related behaviours and the reasons for non-compliance. The study was conducted in two phases. Phase 1 empirical phase which was qualitative, explorative, descriptive in nature. Study population comprised of sixty-two (62) sexually active women aged 18 to 45 years' and ten (10) senior professional nurses trained on insertion of implant contraceptive method, obtained through non-probability purposive sampling method. Data was collected through semi-structured interviews for professional nurses and focus group discussions for sexually active women. Data were analysed thematically and the core concept "*promote the uptake of Implanon*" emerged. Ethical considerations and trustworthiness were ensured.

Phase 2 focused on model development and validation. Concept analysis steps were applied as proposed by Walker and Avant (2014) and was used as building blocks to a model. The model was developed using the six-survey list in Dickoff et al., (1968). The model guidelines were operationalized within the SA National Contraception Clinical guidelines on Subdermal implants. Recommendations for nursing practice and nursing research were made.

Moral regeneration involves the recognition and application of universal moral values. These moral values include human dignity, equality and freedom. However, the most important value is human dignity, as agreed to by all South African. The purpose of the study was to develop a model that could promote moral regeneration among nurses in Limpopo Province, South Africa. The study adopted multiphase methods consisting of three phases (Empirical, concept and model development, and model validation phases). The study was conducted in Limpopo province among nurses and patients who have been admitted to the hospital for at least 4 days. Data collected revealed moral decay and highlighted the need for moral regeneration in the nursing profession. This lead to Phase 2 which involved concept analysis using Walker and Avant steps to clarify and distinguish the identified concept of moral regeneration and develop the model to promote moral regeneration among nurses in Limpopo province using the six elements of the survey list of Dickoff et al. (1968). Recommendations were made concerning the promotion of good ethical-moral behaviour of nurses within the health care system in Limpopo province.

Ndivhuho Mangale`s thesis focused on developing the strategies to strengthen the Monitoring and Evaluation of HIV and AIDS in Limpopo Province. Despite the progress made in South Africa towards 90-90-90 HIV and AIDS targets, HIV and AIDS remain to be a significant public health concern as targets are still not met in Limpopo Province. He used a mixed methods research approach which was conducted in two phases using explanatory sequential mixed methods research design. In the first phase of needs analysis, data was collected to assess the relevance and the design of the current monitoring and evaluation interventions of HIV and AIDS programme in Limpopo province. His study findings revealed that there are still challenges facing Monitoring and Evaluation of poorly performing HIV and AIDS indicators. In Phase 2, he followed a Prescriptive Approach combining SWOT and BOEM analysis to build on the strategies to strengthen the implementation of HIV and AIDS Monitoring and Evaluation framework in Limpopo Province to address gaps and challenges identified in Phase one. He further used Logic Model and Theory of Change approach to link and structure the strategies developed. He consulted stakeholders and experts to validate and adopt the developed strategies. The developed strategies will further enhance achievement of HIV and AIDS 90 - 90 - 90 targets in Limpopo province.

In response to the high rate of TB treatment non-adherence among TB patients in Limpopo Province, Hulisani Matakanye's thesis studied perceptions of the relevant stakeholders and TB patients regarding factors affecting TB treatment adherence in three districts of the province. The findings of the study revealed four categories of factors affecting TB treatment adherence namely patient related, socio-cultural, treatment related and socio-economic factors. Patients' related factors included lack of comprehensive knowledge about the TB and its treatment, consequences of non-adherence, alcohol and substances abuse. Social-cultural factors included strong trust and belief on culture, or religion, which led to patients consulting traditional healers/spiritual healers, fear to disclose their TB status and lack of social support. Treatment related factors included treatment side effects, long treatment duration and TB/HIV co-morbidities. Socio-economic factors included high unemployment rate in the community, lack of transport, distance travelled to the facility and lack of food while patients are taking treatment. To fill those gaps, Hulisani through a series of stakeholder consultative forum workshops guided by Behaviour Change Wheel theory constructs and COM-B components developed intervention strategy called Adherence Improvement Management Strategy (AIMS). The AIMS strategy will use patients' information leaflets delivered face-to-face through door-to-door campaigns by Community Health Workers. The COM-B components aligned leaflets are responding to the factors identified and contains information about TB, transmission, prevention, TB treatment adherence, importance of status disclosure, family support, patient motivation. The AIMS strategy was validated through TB stakeholder consultative forum workshop where TB managers participants agreed that it meets the APEASE criteria. The belief is that the AIMS strategy will help South Africa achieve 90-90-90 Sustainable Development Goal TB targets, reduce TB transmission, occurrence of TB drug resistance, as well as TB morbidity and mortality. Hulisani's thesis has a potential to generate 5 research articles. One manuscript from the thesis is currently under review in accredited peer-reviewed journals.

Wilfred's thesis (presented in article format) developed novel strategies for integrating Indigenous Health Systems and Modern Health System in Mberengwa and Umguza districts in Zimbabwe. These two districts had the highest prevalence of adolescent pregnancies, sexually transmitted diseases, and adolescents engaging in sexual activities compared in Zimbabwe. Split into two phases, the first phase gathered empirical evidence (using a mixed-method survey) on the status quo concerning adolescent sexual health issues and their utilisation of the two health systems. The second phase leveraged the findings from the first phase and then developed and validated five strategies for integrating the two health systems. His research resulted in seven manuscripts submitted to various international peer-reviewed journals, of which two have already been published. The published articles are indicated hereunder.

Title : Intervention Strategies to strengthen Eye Care follow-up among glaucoma patients in selected district hospitals of Limpopo Province, South Africa.

As a response to the high rate of loss to follow-up among glaucoma patients in Limpopo Province, Shonisani Elizabeth Tshivhase's thesis studied factors that contributed to loss to follow-up among glaucoma patients in selected district hospitals of the province. The findings of the study revealed that patients did not understand glaucoma disease and the importance of follow-up. Other factors included denial of glaucoma disease, forgetfulness, lack of money for transport, patients' beliefs on witchcraft/evil spirits which led to consulting traditional healers/ spiritual healers, as well as shortage of glaucoma medication in health care facilities. To mitigate these challenges, Shonisani developed intervention strategies using the Health Belief Model, Social Cognitive Theory and Information, Motivation and Behavior Skills Model. The developed interventions proposes that glaucoma treatment be made available at local clinics to cut transport cost. Furthermore, the developed intervention strategies emphasize the provision of health education and counseling to the patients, family members, and the community using written instructions to increase awareness about glaucoma disease and its consequences. In addition, the strategies emphasize the use of SMS reminders to encourage glaucoma patients to attend follow-up to improve eye health outcomes. Shonisani and the hospitals' eye care managers believes that these intervention strategies might motivate glaucoma patients to remain in care and strengthen eye care follow up in the province thereby helping the country to achieve Sustainable Development goal 3 of ensuring health and wellbeing for all citizens. Shonisani's thesis is a package of four published articles and two manuscripts currently under review in accredited peer-reviewed journals.

Topic : HEDGING IN THE MULTIDISCIPLINARY POSTGRADUATE THESES OF STUDENTS IN A GHANAIAAN UNIVERSITY

Hedging permits writers to gain credibility in academic writing. Through hedging writers shield themselves against any strong force behind their claims and at the same time protect themselves from overstating their claims. The study employed qualitative research method to explore how postgraduate students across seven disciplines from a Ghanaian University appropriated hedging devices in their theses. The study revealed that these students appropriate minimal levels of hedging in their write ups. Furthermore, modal auxiliary verbs were recorded as the most used hedging devices while other hedging devices that seemed complex were barely used. It was also noted that the effectiveness of hedging depends on the title and the nature of the thesis. It is recommended that English Language instructors should revise their syllabuses and include tasks that will involve complex hedging devices. Also, instructors should teach reasons why hedging strategies should be adopted by students.

Title : (Dis)Locations, (Dis)Placements and (Un)Belonging in Zimbabwean White Farmers' Auto/biographies, 1995 to 2010

Using literary methods and deploying theories auto/biography, poststructuralism, critical white feminist studies and postcolonialism, this study explored selected white-written Zimbabwean auto/biographies dealing with farm invasions and dispossessions. It explored (dis)placement, (dis)location and (un)belonging in the selected texts addressing questions and paradoxes that characterise the genre of auto/biography. Notions of truth, memory, subjectivity and history and their articulation were also investigated. The study concludes that auto/biography as form of life writing

focuses on narrative invention, retrospection and projection in (re)constructing targeted life stories. It further observes that this is a paradoxical stance because the present moment of narrative construction is made present in the past that is purported to be recollected. Aporetically then, the past and present constitute a hybrid temporality that erases the boundary between past and present. The study observes that auto/biographies: 1) contribute to the construction of a critical and historically informed constellation of public opinion and, 2) explore the hiatus that established disciplines such as fiction and history do not adequately explain. The study concludes that auto/biography's aptitude to harness both fiction and fact qualifies it as a critical tool to examine, analyse and explore the subtle nuances of the (re)constitution of cultural identities across races.

Title : Range and variability of reporting verbs in doctoral theses of humanities students

The study examined the types, frequency and function of reporting verbs in literature review chapters of fifty-two (52) doctoral theses written by students in Humanities in a Ghanaian university. Shirley Banini categorised reporting verbs using Hyland's (2002) taxonomy. Her analysis reveals that reporting verbs in all three categories (Discourse Acts, Research Acts and Cognitive Acts) were used although verbs in Discourse Acts category were employed more frequently. Students employed reporting verbs to achieve various functions. Social Constructionism and Systemic Functional Grammar were theoretical underpinnings that guided her study. She recommends that lecturers of academic writing use corpus-based data in teaching reporting verbs, faculty are trained to better assist students in effective writing, and a refresher course provided to students in the correct use of citations and reporting verbs at the onset of their doctoral programmes to make their writings more impactful.

Title : POLITICS OF BELONGING IN SOUTH AFRICA SINCE 2008

In the thesis, Politics of Belonging in South Africa Since 2008, Mr Kehinde examined the intermittent violence against African foreign nationals that has characterised the first two decades of the 21st century South African social space. Mr Kehinde noted that, in part, this violence has been fueled by the unprecedented influx of African immigrants into South Africa since 1994. The trend has been propelled by relative economic and political stability of South Africa that attracts people from all over sub-Saharan Africa who are escaping the ravages of fractured economies and political instabilities of their own countries. The study deployed a qualitative methodology of documentary analysis and in-depth interviews to examine identity politics and the insider-outsider relations in contemporary South Africa and proffered a nuanced analysis of the problems that beset South Africa due to contested belonging emanating from competition for scarce economic resources. The originality of Mr Kehinde's study derives from its attempt to draw from extensive literature about the politics of naming and contested belonging to bridge the chasm that seem to divide those who view themselves as native South Africans and those who are seen as intruders. The study concludes that the increase in xenophobia or specifically Afro-phobia, is part of the global challenges related to migrations that are forced upon people as they try to escape social and economic inequalities in their countries of origin. It is under these fraught economic and poli.

Topic : ASSESSMENT OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPONENT OF THE MATURE STUDENTS' ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS INTO SELECTED GHANAIAN UNIVERSITIES

To deal with recognition of prior learning, Ghanaian universities introduced The Mature Students' Entrance Examinations (MSEE) as an alternative examination to undergraduate enrolment. Using the multiple case study design as the study's primary technique, the study focused on the English language component of the MSEE. It was found that the English language component of the MSEE fell short of both the West African Senior School Certificate Examination which is the main examination used for university entrance in Ghana and the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) standards in the areas such as the uniformity of the questions set, the basic language skills gauged, the criteria used for setting the questions and the competences assessed in the examination. The study recommends the centralization of the MSEE. Furthermore, language practitioners should be adequately trained in language testing.

To be able to communicate effectively and succeed in an academic discourse community, a student requires sufficient competence in the use of the medium of teaching and learning which in this case is the English language. However, it is observable that the writing of most students, especially in English as second and/or foreign language contexts, tends to be fraught with some recurrent errors. This phenomenon motivated Ms Mandor to apply Error Analysis procedures to analyse the English language errors in the written compositions of second year students in a Ghanaian university. A mixed-method approach was used to explore error taxonomies and to obtain error frequencies. The findings revealed that students demonstrated poor writing skills with inherent grammatical errors and a lack of cohesion, and coherence. A total of 16 error categories were detected. Based on the findings, the study suggested a revision of the academic literacy curriculum and the methods of its teaching as an academic support programme for university students.

In this qualitative study, Sikitime explores the affordances of multiple semiotic modes as ensembles. The compositional features of the selected multimodal texts were of spatial, visual, gestural and linguistic design. Furthermore, the interpretative skills of level 300 Media Studies students on selected multimodal texts were also explored. The findings of the study revealed that meaning given to semiotic modes is not overt nor fixed. It is rather determined by conventions which are of genre orientations, discipline specific and socio-cultural conventions. Thus, decoding meaning given to multimodal text is as a result a complex cognitive undertaking which requires High Order Thinking and refined perceptual skills. It is imperative that Critical Literacies become an integral part undergraduate literacy programmes since they underpin requisite knowledge base associated with New Literacies.

Topic : READABILITY INDEX ASSESSMENT OF NON-PRESCRIBED SUPPLEMENTARY ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEXTBOOKS IN SELECTED GHANAIAN SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS

The study assessed the readability levels of non-prescribed supplementary English Language textbooks used by some private Senior High Schools (SHSs) in Ghana and how they affect the learning outcomes of their students. Using a mixed method approach, data was gathered from interviews conducted for twelve participants from five private SHSs, three Monitoring and Supervision officers Ghana Education Service (GES) - Adentan and a Curriculum Officer for Languages from National Council for Curriculum Assessment (NaCCA). The study also subjected ninety-one comprehension passages from four commonly used non-prescribed supplementary English Language textbooks to seven readability formulas to determine their

readability levels and age appropriateness for SHS students. The results were further subjected to descriptive statistical analysis using SPSS version 21 and compared to comprehension test scores obtained from a test administered to a sampled size of 492 SHS 1-3 students from the five selected private SHSs. The statistical analysis revealed that most of the comprehension passages were either too high or too low for the readability levels of the SHS students. This shows that the criteria used by National Council for Curriculum and Assessment (NaCCA) and private SHSs to prescribe and select the textbooks are not scientific. It was also realized that readability could not predict the overall performance of SHS students based on the comprehension tests. It is therefore recommended that NaCCA collaborates with the District Education Offices to enforce the use of prescribed textbooks in all pre-tertiary institutions especially private schools.

The unconditional forecasting structures of non-time varying GARCH models impose monotonic mean reversion paths on medium to long-term volatility forecasts when breaks and changes in the unconditional volatility are ignored or not appropriately accounted for. This leads to over-estimated or under-estimated volatilities and forecasts paths, which are unrepresentative of the underlying asset. Therefore, to address this problem, stochastic time-variations in the unconditional volatility forecasts of GARCH models were induced under the assumption that the unconditional volatility processes are driven by the levels of market uncertainties. Alternative proxies were then identified and used to construct break variables, which were then jointly passed to the variance equations of the GARCH models to augment the models. Before the models were used in forecasting, a hypothetical study of the mutual dependencies between the volatilities and the covariates (proxies and their break variables) was carried out to investigate the predictive powers of the covariates. Evidence from the hypothetical study revealed that the covariates have substantial predictive abilities. On the other hand, evidence from the volatility forecasting indicates that the forecasts based on our approach revert along stochastic paths towards their long-run variances. Relatively improvements or insignificant loss of forecast accuracies but higher explanatory forecasting powers were also observed. Evidence from the VaR forecasting also points toward lower failure rates and relatively superior forecast accuracies for the 1% VaR forecasts, but the same cannot be said about the 5% forecasts, although, the forecasts yielded lower asymmetric losses. Furthermore, the augmented VaR models produced lower mean daily capital requirements and most the models avoided the regulatory penalty zones imposed by the Basel II Accord. Based on the results from the studies, we recommend the use of our proposed method to forecast volatility and VaR for exchange rates, to financial institutions, investors and

other practitioners for risk management and policy decision-making. It is believed that VaR forecasts based on our approach or in aggregation with forecasts from internal models may lead to fewer bank failures, optimal exposure to market risks and banks may meet regulatory capital requirements without been sanctioned.

Topic : PHYTOCHEMICAL STUDIES OF AQUEOUS EXTRACTS OF THE KIRKIA WILMSII TUBER

This study investigated the phytochemical properties of *Kirkia wilmsii* to cover the gap left by researchers who concentrated on ethnobotanical surveys that showed that *K. wilmsii* is used traditionally for the treatment of hypertension, fever, malaria, toothache and diabetes mellitus. It was established that suitable solvents for the phytochemical extraction of the *K. wilmsii* tubers are ethanol, methanol, methanol/chloroform/water, 80% methanol, 60% methanol and water. Non-polar solvents cannot be used as they gave very low yields. Phytochemical screening confirmed the presence of phenolics, flavonoids, terpenoids, tannins, cardenolides and reducing sugars. Total phenolic content and total flavonoid content analysis proved the presence of high levels of phenolic compounds as well as flavonoids which could be responsible for the radical scavenging activities observed. Antimicrobial activity tests were performed using the disc diffusion (Kirby-Bauer) method showed that the extracts were potent against gram positive and gram negative pathogenic bacteria. The most potent extracts were 80% methanol, 50% acetone, MCW and 80% ethanol. The minimum inhibitory concentration of 80% acetone (against *S. aureus*) and 80% methanol (against *E. coli* and *S. typhi*) were comparable to values for a well-known broad spectrum antibiotic amoxicillin. Three papers were published from this research, two were submitted for consideration and two more are being drafted.

Topic : THE RATE OF RECOLONIZATION BY NATIVE PLANT SPECIES AFTER THE ERADICATION OF INVASIVE ALIEN PLANT SPECIES IN LIMPOPO PROVINCE, SOUTH AFRICA

Invasive alien plant species found in riparian zones are known to compete with native plant species for several essential resources. Such competition results in altering of the functioning of plant communities. The aim of the study was to investigate the rate of recolonization by native plant species after the eradication of alien invasive plant species. This was done by measuring the rate of recolonization by native species after the removal of alien invasive species and by identifying factors to consider for recolonization to occur. The study was carried out in the Waterberg and Makhado district municipalities, Limpopo Province, on three farms highly infested with alien invasive plant species (*Acacia decurrens*, *Populus alba* and *Lantana camara*). Results from the study indicated that in the case of *Acacia decurrens* and *Lantana camara*, recolonization of native species can be possible with continued monitoring and management, as some native grass and herb species were emerging on the study sites. *Populus alba* proved troublesome due to its ability to reproduce vegetatively through root suckering, which enables it to subsequently re-occupy the study area in larger numbers than before. It is concluded that, recolonization by native plants is possible, although it needs monitoring. The study came up with an adaptive management plan which could assist local and provincial conservation agencies in improvement of ecosystem dynamics. One article has been published while another one is under review in an accredited peer-reviewed journal.
