In between work at Head Office, Eric represented South Africa as a South African Diplomat in Nigeria (1997-99), Norway (1999-01), Hong Kong (2002-06), Belgium & Luxembourg (2008-11) and France (2012-17) at the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). In 2018, he completed a short Leadership & Economic Diplomacy Programme at the Civil Service College in Singapore.

Eric was a strategic team player in the DIRCO lobby team that secured South Africa's non-permanent seat in the United Nations Security Council for 2019/20; a skill that he brings to the Convocation to advocate for investment opportunities.

He is no stranger to University Governance as he served as SRC member; Vice-President (External) in 1993 & Secretary-General in 1991 and as Treasurer of the Law Students Faculty Council and member of the Legal Aid Clinic, 1988/9.

Makatu is a serving member of Progressive International, a global initiative with a mission to unite, organize, and mobilize progressive forces around the world.

Recently, he raised funds from the National Film and Video Foundation, South Africa and the Government of the Region of Flanders, Belgium for *Mutoli wa Mbila na Vhavenda Vho-JK Mathoho* documentary film, which is under production and to premiere soon in South Africa and at the Afrika Film Festival in the university city of Leuven, Belgium.
