ICGEB SPECIAL PROGRAMME with South African HDIs

The International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology and the South African Department of Science and Innovation have partnered in a Special Programme to develop and support capacity development in South African Historically Disadvantaged Institutions (HDIs).

The ICGEB invites proposals from Principal Investigators (South African citizens and South African permanent residents), in South African HDIs to run joint scientific events, workshops and practical training courses in the Life Sciences, human healthcare, industrial and agricultural biotechnology and the bio-economy, to be co-organised with ICGEB researchers.

There is also an additional funding opportunity for researchers and students from HDIs to apply for funding to attend ICGEB Meetings and Courses in Africa, as well as a limited number in Trieste, Italy and New Delhi, India.

Eligible HDIs:

University of Fort Hare, University of Limpopo, University of Venda, Walter Sisulu University, University of the Western Cape, University of Zululand, Mangosuthu University of Technology, and Sefako Makgatho Health Sciences University.
