Eligibility Criteria:

- PhD qualification (preferably in Economics, Developmental Studies, Psychology, or a sector-related field).
- > Proven ability to publish papers in accredited peer-reviewed journals.
- > Experience with data analysis and large-scale data sets.
- South African citizenship, with preference given to applicants from designated groups.
- > People living with disabilities are strongly encouraged to apply.
