The library has more than 154,884 printed books, 36,860 e-books, 5,796 e-serials, 16,040 research documents, and 2,134 articles and theses in the UNIIVEN Institutional Repository, as well as access to National and International electronic information resources to meet the teaching, study, and research needs of students and staff. It also provides past examination question papers that are available online. Univen Library comprises the following sections: Circulation, Law Library, Periodicals, Reference Services, Special Collections, Information Commons, and ICT Services. Cataloguing, acquisitions

1. MyLibrary! App

The Univen Library offers a mobile application for Android and iOS devices, allowing students and staff to easily access library services on the go. The Library App can be used to:

- Search the library catalogue.
- Scan the ISBNs of external books to access their titles via the library.
- Place and cancel holds on Items.
- Renew checked-out items.
- View or renew your borrowed items.
- View your accumulated fines.

2. Main Issue Section

The section provides services to all students and staff. The loan items period is as follows:

User Category	Items	Loan Days
Undergraduates	3	7
Postgraduates	6	30
Academic staff	20	90
Administrative staff	10	30
Service staff	6	30

Upon request, the loan period can be extended for an additional equivalent period. Renewals maybe done telephonically.

A late return fine of R8 per book per day applies to overdue books from the open shelves.

3. Reserve Section

This section keeps prescribed books that are in high demand and theses and dissertations. All users may borrow one item at a time. The loan period is two hours per item which may be extended for another two hours. An overnight loan applies from 21:00 on Mondays to Thursdays, from 19:00 on Fridays, and from 13:00 on Saturdays. Items must be returned at 09:00 on the following working day.

A late return fine of R10 per book per hour in excess of two hours applies.



4. Inter-library Loan Service

This service assists staff, Masters and PhD students to obtain books and journal articles which are not available in the Univen Library. This service is available for free.

5. Special Collections Service

This service offers access to material on Venda, rare books, material about Univen and the Eskia Mphahlele collection. Material may only be used in the Special Collections Section.

6. Law Library

The law library section is available to students doing law courses. Users may borrow one item at a time for a period of two hours. Overnight and weekend rules, as well as fine rules, apply as per the reserve section above.

7. Disabled Students Unit (DSU)

A special study room for disabled students is available on the ground floor, equipped with specialized equipment. DSU Students are advised to book computers online at Create Booking or by using the booking computers provided at the DSU room. Computers are dedicated to academic activities ONLY.

9. A-Z Databases

The library access to online databases, journals, books, Magazines, Newspapers, theses and dissertations, reports, research tools, learning tools, and other electronic resources

10. Photocopying & Printing services

Photocopies can be made at a fee of 70c per copy. Students make use of their student cards to make copies. Copying is done within the regulations laid down by the Copyright Act of 1978.

8. Reference Services

Reference services include assistance in searches and training on the use of library resources. Queries can be addressed to dedicated Information Librarians. Students are advised to book online for a physical or online Reference Services appointment and training. Services offered include information searches and training (group and 1-on-1) on use of databases.

- **Computing Services**

Computers are available for all registered students on the ground floor, first floor, Law Library, and Reserve Section. Computers are also provided for DSU-registered students in the DSU room. Students should book computers online or via the Booking PCs located on the ground floor and in the DSU room for DSU-registered students. All student computers are strictly for academic use ONLY.

- **Laptop Area**

A dedicated laptop area with Wi-Fi connection is allocated on the ground floor for all students. Students are expected to bring along their own laptops.

- **Group Workrooms**

Group workrooms are only available for group discussions by all registered students. Students are advised to book online before the discussion and to check in and out at the Learning Commons Desk.
