SENEX RESOLUTION ON THE REVIEW OF RULE G10 OF THE GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

RE: SENEX RESOLUTION ON THE REVIEW OF RULE G10 OF THE GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

At its special meeting of 23 February 2026 the Executive Committee of Senate (Senex) resolved to amend parts of Rule G10 of the General Rules and Regulations (G10.2; G10.3 and G10.4) as follows, for ratification by Senate:

- (i) With regard to a four-year qualification, to register for second and third year modules a student is required to have passed sixty percent (60%) of first year and second year modules respectively; and to register for the final year the student must have passed all first, second and third year modules; provided that in the final year of study a student may apply to the Executive Dean to add one or two outstanding modules to complete the degree. Permission shall be dependent upon good academic progress and the student not exceeding the maximum number of FTE credits.
- (ii) With regard to a three-year qualification, to register for second year modules a student is required to have passed sixty percent (60%) of first year modules; and to register for the final year the student must have passed all first and second year modules; provided that in the final year of study a student may apply to the Executive Dean to add one or two outstanding modules to complete the degree. Permission shall be dependent upon good academic progress and the student not exceeding the maximum number of FTE credits.
- (iii) The parameters as to the modules that a student shall be permitted to carry over to the next level as contemplated above shall be subject to the specific requirements of each faculty, taking into account considerations such as core modules, pre-requisite modules, co-requisite modules etc.
