ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstracts should:

- Be 250 words
- Clearly state the research/problem context, objective, methodology or approach, key findings, and relevance to the conference theme
- Indicate the preferred theme and presentation format (oral or poster)
- Include author name(s), institutional affiliation(s), and contact details

FULL PAPER GUIDELINES (FOR ACCEPTED ABSTRACTS)

- Length: 6000 – 8000 words
- Structured academic or professional format
- Original, unpublished work
- Harvard referencing style

NB: Selected high-quality papers will be considered for publication in peer-reviewed outlets, including Scopus-indexed and Web of Science-indexed journals, DHET-accredited journals, and an edited book volume of conference chapters, subject to formal peer-review processes and editorial selection criteria.
